Odin/Jason Odin (Jason Voorhees in the 2015 film) is a fictional character who appears in several of the Friday the 13th media franchises, the first being the original film by Sean Cunningham. The character Jason Voorhees, portrayed by 1980s horror icon, Kane Hodder, is the primary antagonist of the franchise. The character first appeared in the 1982 film Friday the 13th, which was followed by The New Blood, Final Chapter, Part 2 and Jason X. All of the films

feature the character of Jason Voorhees, culminating in the 2015 film Friday the 13th, where Jason was portrayed by none other than Kane Hodder. The character of Jason Voorhees was originally a focus for the franchise in the early 1980s, when it was planned that a second Friday the 13th film, to be released in 1981, would feature a character named "Odin". However, when Kenny Firestone was brought on board to helm

the film, he rejected the concept, feeling that Hodder was the only character who could carry the franchise over the finish line.

Consequently, Hodder's portrayal of Jason Voorhees has become synonymous with the character. Although Hodder played Jason in all of the sequels, the character's role in the first film deviated considerably from his role in the sequels. He was completely different

in the first film, and only resembled Jason in the final third of the film. Some fans also felt Jason was more of a comic relief character in the first film than a main antagonist. However, as time went on, Hodder's portrayal of Jason became a more serious character, that would become predominant in later sequels. Appearances
